There is / There are

There is a / an / + singular countable nouns

There is some + uncountable nouns.

There are + plural countable nouns.

Examples:

- *There is a banana on the table.*
- *There is some water in the fridge.*
- *There is some coffee in the kitchen.*
- *There is an apple in the basket.*
- *There is some tea in the teapot.*
- *There is an orange in the plate.*
- *There are some grapes in the fridge.*
- *There are some carrots in the kitchen.*
- *There are some eggs on the table.*
- *There are some potatoes in the basket.*

Is there a / an / any?

Are there any?

- *Is there an apple in the kitchen? → Yes, **there is**. Or No, **there isn't**.*
- *Is there a banana on the table? → Yes, **there is**.*
- *Is there any water in the bottle? → No, **there isn't**.*
- *Is there any tea in the teapot? → Yes, **there is** / yes, **there is** some.*
- *Are there any grapes on the table? → Yes, **there are**.*
- *Are there any onions in the basket? → No, **there aren't**.*
