Expressing Permission

1. **Can I go out?**
 - *Yes, you can.*
2. **2/ Can I watch TV?**
 - *No, you can't.*
3. **3/ Can I go to the cinema?**
 - *No, you can't.*
4. **4/ Can I sit near Rachid?**
 - *Yes, you can.*
5. **5/ Can I change my place?**
 - *Yes, you can.*
6. **6/ Can I drink some water?**
 - *Yes, you can.*
7. **7/ Can I eat some biscuits?**
 - *No, you can't.*
8. **8/ Can I listen to music?**
 - *No, you can't.*
9. **9/ Can I use your pen?**
 - *Yes, you can.*
10. **10/ Can I play football?**
 - *Yes, you can.*

Things I can do in the classroom: I can read – I can speak – I can exchange ideas, etc.

Things I can't do in the classroom: I can't sleep – I can't listen to the radio – I can't eat or drink – I can't play football, etc.

Rule: Asking for permission: *Can + Subject + verb*

Accepting: *Yes, you / he / she / they can*

Refusing: *No, you / he / she / they can't*
